A message from the President of SoCo Rescue

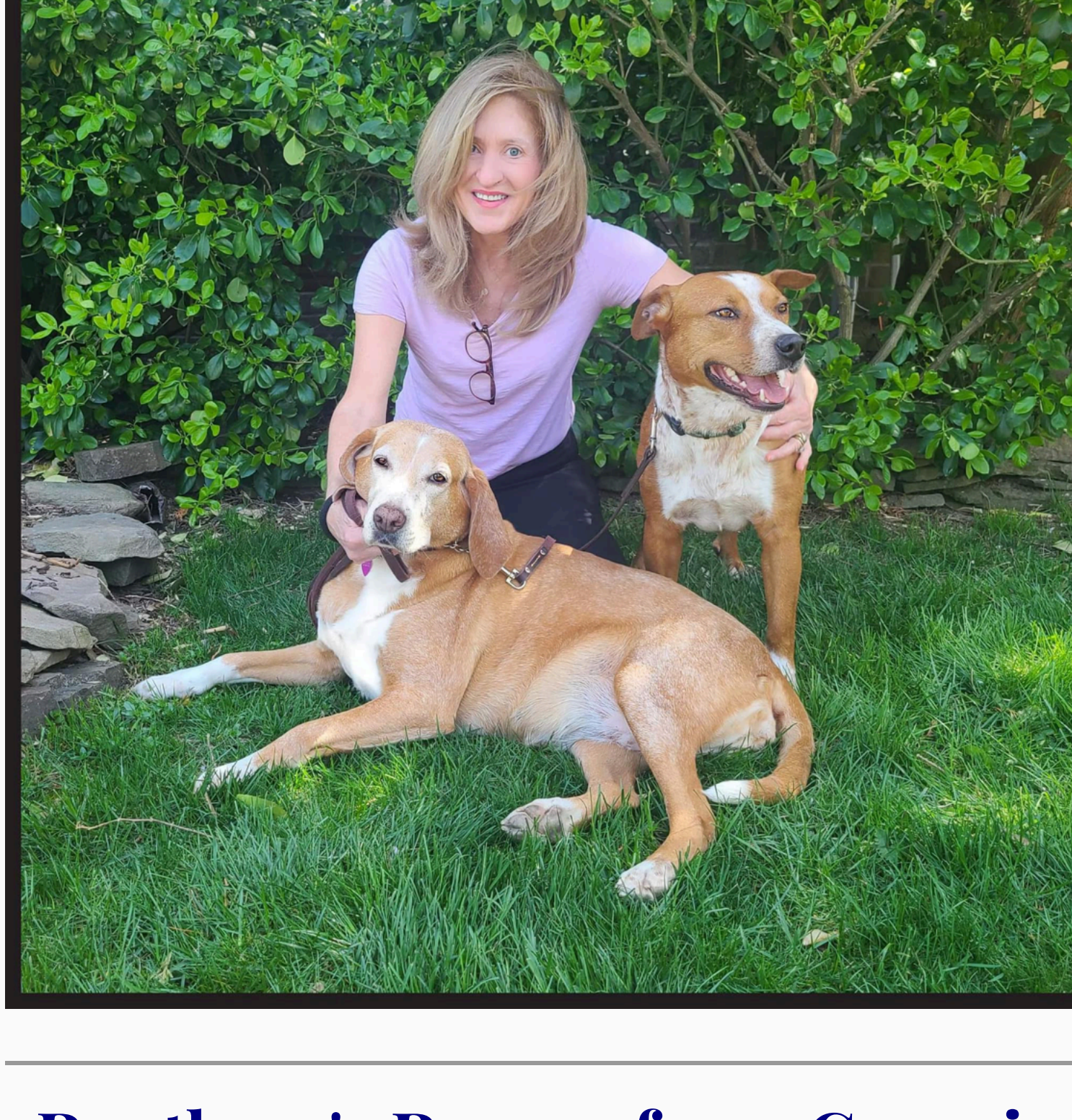

Adoptions are typically slow in the summer with everyone traveling and taking vacations. We were able to have monthly adoption events and are very thankful to all of your foster friends who make this possible. At the same time, there have been daily requests for us to take in stray dogs, help abandoned litters and rescue pups awaiting euthanasia at our local animal control. As we strive to save as many lives as we can, in July we faced a financial crisis, a breaking point. It truly brings tears to my eyes to recall all the ways you folks helped out. Our staff went without pay. My plea for donations social media brought in more than \$10,000 in one weekend. Packages of all kinds of supplies arrived each day. As we move forward, we continue to need more resources than our monthly adoption fees.
